A native Oregonian, Mrs. Masterson has made her home in this area for almost forty years. She graduated with a Latin major from the University of Oregon in 1921. For two years after her graduation she taught in Lane and Clackamas counties.

In 1923 Mr. and Mrs. Masterson moved to Curry County. The next twenty years she spent taking care of her family. During this time she occasionally tutored children who were unable to attend school.

In 1944 she started teaching school again at the old high school in Port Orford, and in 1953 she again retired. When Langlois and Port Orford consolidated in 1955, Mrs. Masterson was asked to teach Latin at the newly formed Pacific High School. This is her fourth and last year at Pacific.

Mrs. Masterson will be missed next year both by the students and the faculty. Her interest in young people has made her an understanding friend as well as an inspiring teacher.

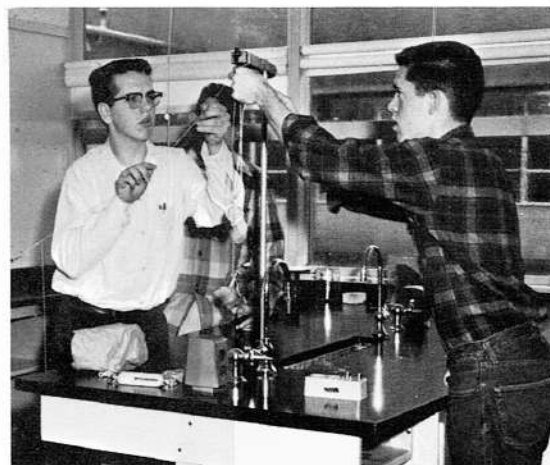

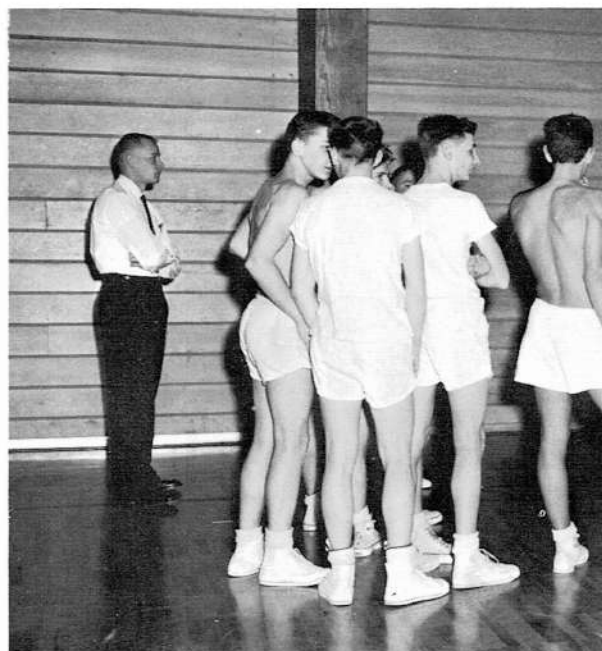

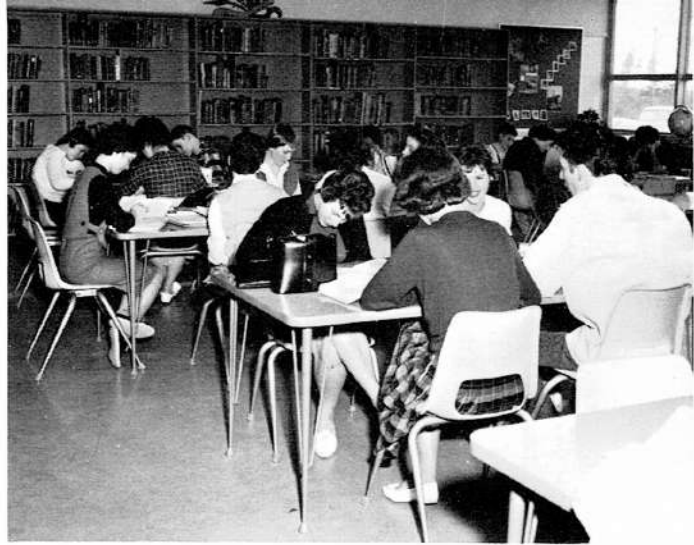

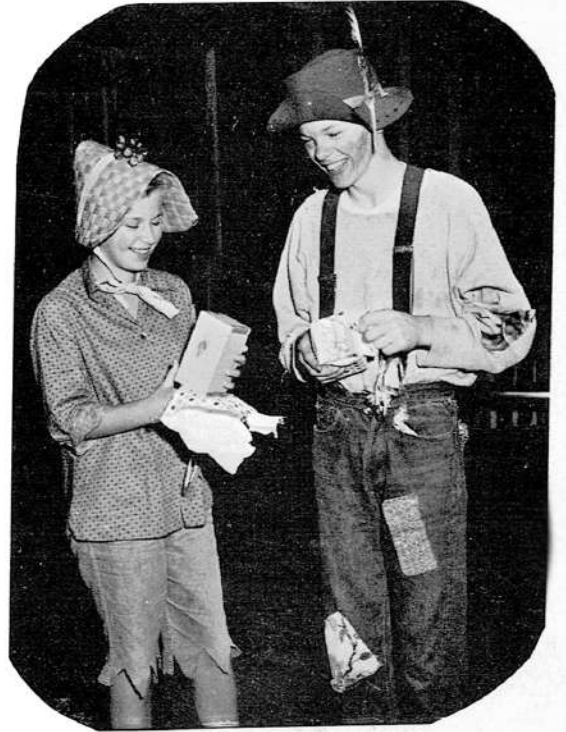
